In addition to the juried crafts, we sponsor daylong live entertainment by local performing artists and children's art and activities. The **Festival** offers free admission and parking, and is a highly anticipated fall event.

To participate in the **Festival**, please send to us:

- 3) A self-addressed envelope stamped with *sufficient* return postage & size; \*
- 4) An \$85 registration fee payable to The Brookline Council for the Arts & Humanities, Inc. (the fee is \$80 if your application is post-marked no later than June 20<sup>th</sup>.)

**\* Past participants 2004-2007 need not submit material for jurying**

**The application deadline is August 15, 2008.**

You will be notified of the jury's decision within a month of receipt and no later than August 22, 2008. If you are accepted to the **Festival**, your registration fee will not be returned. If the jury does not accept your entry, your registration fee will be returned.

**By applying to the **Festival**, you are agreeing to the following terms & conditions:**

- \* All crafts must be handmade by exhibitors: no imports, kits or manufactured items. If crafts are determined to be not handmade at the time of the **Festival**, you will not be permitted to participate and your fee will not be returned.
- \* Exhibitors will sell only the media indicated on the application.
- \* Each exhibitor will receive approximately 10' x 10' of outdoor space.
- \* Set-up time begins at 8:00 a.m. on the day of the **Festival**.
- \* Each exhibitor will remain in place from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- \* All tables, signs and props must be supplied by the exhibitor.
- \* Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up his or her space.
